## FIRST ANNOUNCEMENT

This seminar is the 21<sup>st</sup> in the series of international seminars on paste and thickened tailings (P&TT) initiated by the ACG in 1999, and reflects the developing maturity of P&TT management. Paste 2018 seeks to explore the considerations needed to raise the mining industry leaders' awareness of how important environmental stewardship, with regard to their tailings facilities, is to long-term industry sustainability.

Over the past decade, the potential benefits to be gained from adopting thickened tailings technology on mining operations have become widely accepted, and there would be few mine feasibility studies presently undertaken that do not include this as an option to be evaluated. Very interestingly, a number of operations are now retrofitting their plants and tailings storages from conventional to thickened technology. The reason for this is the increase in the mass of tailings that can be accommodated on a given footprint and, more importantly, the greater volume of water that can be recovered for reuse in the plant in arid areas.

## WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This seminar represents a valuable opportunity for academics, designers, practitioners, consultants and suppliers to discuss best practice, improved methods and technology, all with an emphasis on safety, efficiency and environmental impact.

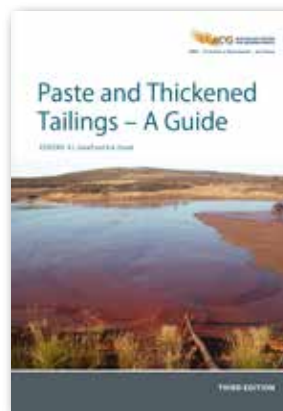
